# Las Vegas Justice Court Specialty Courts



## **Mental Health Court** (minimum 12-month program)

- Must have a serious mental illness
  - Must be determined to be moderate to high risk/high needs (based on evidenced based screening tools)
- Must reside in Clark County
- We have very limited housing options for Tier 3 sex offenders. Placement will be on a case-by-case basis, if available

## **Multiple Offender DUI Court** (minimum 12-month program)

- Must have at least 2 lifetime DUI arrest
- Must reside in the Las Vegas area

## **Adult Drug Court** (minimum 18-month program)

- Identified substance use disorder
  - Can have low-to-moderate mental health needs as well
- All history of violent offenses or drug trafficking/sales will be staffed on an individual basis
- No history of sex offenses or arson

## **Veterans Treatment Court** (minimum 12-month program)

- Veterans or members of the U.S. Military only
- Must have a *service-related* substance use or mental health issue
- No history of sex offenses or arson

## **Community Court** There are 2 program options:

### **Resources Program** (minimum 6-month program)

- Needs identifying documents and/or connection to services
  - Examples: NV identification, birth certificate, SS card

### **Treatment Program** (minimum 9-month program)

- Identified substance use disorder

### **Both Programs:**

- Must have low level, quality of life misdemeanor(s) only
  - Examples: trespassing; loitering; drug paraphernalia; glass container
- Must have housing instability
- No history of arson, violent crime, sex offenses, drug trafficking/sales, severe mental illness
- No open felony cases

# An Evidence-Based Approach to Care Medication Assisted Treatment

Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) is an evidence-based approach to opioid treatment that helps improve relapse rates, reduce overdose deaths and enhance patient well-being



## ***Reduced Opioid Use***

**80%** of CTC patients are illicit opioid-free after six months, compared to the national average of 45%<sup>1</sup>



## ***Improved Treatment Retention***

**60%** of CTC patients are still in treatment after 90 days as compared to industry estimates as low as 20%<sup>2</sup>



## ***Diminished Overdose Deaths***

The mortality rate for individuals with OUD is **8.2x** higher outside of MAT compared to those enrolled<sup>3</sup>



## ***Curbed Hospital Admissions***

A **35%** reduction in hospital admissions for patients diagnosed with OUD has reduced healthcare burden<sup>4</sup>



## ***Increase in Employment***

MAT is associated with a **49%** increase in employment status after six months in treatment<sup>5</sup>
