 A transformative initiative designed to address drug crime, addiction, and homelessness by offering a second chance to those in need. Rather than funneling individuals into the justice system, LIMA redirects participants to community-based services to receive the treatment and support they need to turn their lives around. With a focus on those battling chemical
